**Lecture Title: Oral Inflammation and
Links to Systemic Diseases:
Periodontal Care with a Focus on
“Oral Inflammatory Load” Reduction**

Dr. Glogauer is an internationally-recognized dental clinician scientist and a leader in the fields of dentistry, oral immunity, oral diseases, alveolar bone grafting and the links between oral health and systemic health. He is a Professor at the Faculty of Dentistry, University of Toronto, Head of Dentistry for University Health Network and Chief of Dental Oncology at Princess Margaret Cancer Centre. He has received awards for recognition of scientific excellence (Quality of Life research award from Canadian Institutes of Health Research (CIHR)-IMHA-2006) and has been funded by MRC/CIHR since 1994. He has generated over 240 peer reviewed publications in the fields of dentistry, oral health and immunology with over 20,500 citations and an H-Factor of 70. He has 5 patents and is CEO and co-founder of start-up Ostia Sciences which focuses on the oral microbiome testing and probiotic development.
